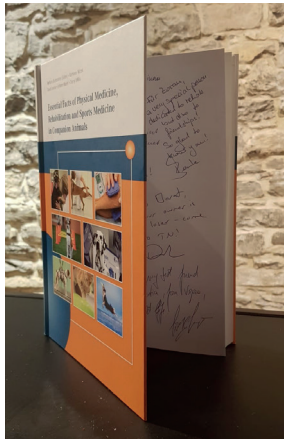


MBST Kernspin-VET-Therapy in new veterinary standard work
